What is Title 1?

Title I is a federally funded entitlement program that provides supplemental resources to high-poverty schools. These resources are intended to:

- Promote high academic achievement for all children
- Improve teaching and learning
- Increase parent and community involvement

How Title 1 Works

The federal government provides funding to states each year for Title I. The Florida Department of Education distributes the money to the district. The school district identifies eligible schools and provides Title I funds.

Parent/Guardian Rights

- To be involved and request regular meetings to express your opinions and concerns;

- To request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teachers and paraprofessionals
- To be informed if your child is taught by a non-highly qualified teacher for four or more consecutive weeks
